Dear Antioch #34 Employee,

As you are likely aware, the District is transitioning to a K-5 structure for all our elementary schools beginning in the 2019-2020 school year. The District will then have three K-5 schools (Hillcrest, Oakland & W.C. Petty), one 6-8 school (AUGS), and one Early Learning (Birth-3, EC, ECAT, Pre-K) School (Antioch Elementary School). This change will impact staff, students, and the community. In order to prepare for this change, we have begun planning all aspects of this shift including new school boundaries, facility enhancements, and staffing.

The purpose of this communication is to share the process we will use for placement of staff for the 2019-2020 school year. The AEEA contract provides language that gives the District latitude when it comes to staffing. Section 12.3 Transfers reads; "this Article 12 shall not be applicable to circumstances in which significant staff transfers are required, such as the staffing of a new building". Although the contract gives the District the right to place certified staff, the administration would like to seek employee input as it relates to staffing of schools for the 2019-2020 school year. The administration would like to demonstrate a good faith effort to understand the preferences of the staff prior to making staffing assignments.

In collaboration with AEEA leadership, we have created an Employee Interest Survey that will allow you to identify your employment preferences for the 2019-2020 school year. It is obviously not possible to grant every employee their primary employment preference; however, this information will be helpful as we plan for staffing in the 2019-2020 school year. It is our hope to have all placements finalized by the Spring of 2018, and staff will be notified via placement letter no later than the last day of the school year. Placements are subject to change due to student counts and other uncontrollable variables.




- 5 initial boundary scenario options were reviewed by the DLT.

- All feedback was shared with Decision Insight (D.I).
- Administration reviewed feedback & scenarios to begin eliminating less desirable options.
- D.I. provided 3 additional options to enhance favorable options.
- Through this process, 2 viable options remain (options #5 & 6).
- Administration also met with Transportation to solicit feedback.
- On Friday, November 3rd, a conference call was held with D.I. to review boundary scenarios and determine if any additional enhancements could be made on the remaining 2 desireable scenarios.




Objectives for a Boundary Realignment and Grade Level Reconfiguration

Design a Boundary realignment that will:

- Reconfigure grade levels to a kindergarten through fifth grade structure to reduce the number of required school transitions for Antioch students.
- > Create contiguous boundaries for all schools.
- ➤ Balance enrollment for elementary schools for the next five to ten years, based on each school's appropriate capacity.




Plotting Students by Residence



Zooming in on Neighborhoods and Streets



The Oakland Elementary School Improvement project has been submitted to the Village for review in regards to Site Plan Review and Planning and Zoning Requirements. It is our understanding that the Village is requiring sidewalk improvements along the entire Deep Lake Road street frontage and that street trees be placed every 33' along both Deep Lake Road and W. Grass Lake Road to meet the street tree zoning code. The district wants to comply with all Village and zoning requirements, but these improvements have a large cost impact on the project budget that were not previously expected. The district would like to work with the Village to try and reduce these costs or spread out the costs of these improvements over multiple years. The district would like to make the following requests in regards to the costs of these improvements:

- Share the cost of the new sidewalk along Deep Lake Road street frontage with the Village at a 50% split. The sidewalk required along Deep Lake Road is over 900' in length and is a significant cost. The sidewalk will benefit both school users and Lake Villa residents in regards to a safer route to the school and adjacent roadways. As such we feel this should be a shared cost with the Village.
- Street Tree Requirement along Deep Lake Road and W. Grass Lake Road be phased over a 5 year period to help alleviate the immediate cost of the required 42+ trees. The trees would be spaced at larger tree spacing intervals over 5 years and gradually be filled in to meet the zoning code requirement. Install approximately 8-10 trees per year.
