From the Health Office:

Reminder regarding illness - Do Not send students to school if they are ill. Parents will be called and students identified as ill will be sent home.

Students need to stay home if they have a fever of 100.4 degrees or above the night before school or the morning of school. Do not medicate your student and send him/her to school.

Students need to be fever free for 24 hours, without the aid of a fever reducing medication, before returning to school.

Students need to be free from vomiting and/or diarrhea for 24 hours before returning to school.

Please have a plan in place in case you are called to pick your student up due to illness or injury.

Please pick your student up in a timely manner if you are called. Also, update phone numbers, by calling the office, when they change.
