



Terminology

- RIT Unit of measure for MAP assessment, the score








3 Year Spring NWEA Math Mean RIT Score by Grade Level








3 Year Spring NWEA English/Language Arts Student Distribution by Percentile Bands




3 Year Winter NWEA Math Student Distribution by Percentile Bands





Spring NWEA English/Language Arts Personal Growth Target Achievement by Cohort




Spring NWEA Math Personal Growth Target Achievement by Cohort
