

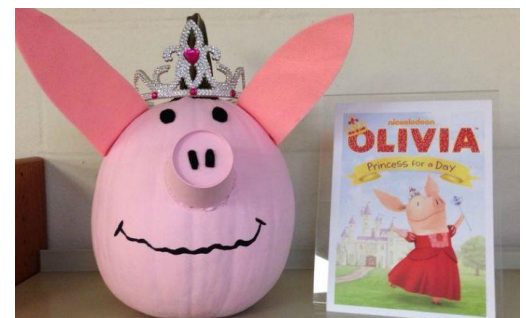
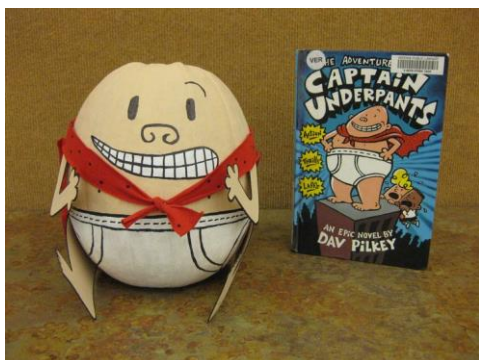
Storybook Pumpkin Patch

Project: Decorate a pumpkin/tissue box to look like a book character

The story book character pumpkin is a fun, *optional* at-home project for parents and children to do together! Parents, please help your child choose a favorite book and decorate a pumpkin to look like the main character from that book. **Be sure to use a small/medium sized pumpkin (he/she may use a tissue box instead) that your child can carry by themselves.** You may choose any way to decorate the pumpkin, as long as it goes with the character in the book. Some ideas are pictured below and there are many more online you can check out. Students have used spray paint, pipe cleaners, clay, fake hair, felt, accessories, glitter, etc. Please work with your child on this project, but please do not do it for him/her. Students who bring in a decorated pumpkin will receive a special brag tag and be entered in the October raffle prize. Students whose names are chosen from the raffle will be able to pick a prize from the LMC treasure chest.

[Your child will be presenting their pumpkin to the class using the attached sheet, so please encourage them to complete it]. Students may bring in their decorated pumpkin, along with the book (name on it please), anytime throughout October. Projects will be displayed in the Petty Library.
