Math

Numbers to 5, counting, sorting, matching numbers to items counted, hidden partners, 2D & 3D shapes.

Foundational Skills

We will be identifying & producing rhymes, identifying & segmenting syllables, and blending words



Reading

In reading, we will be learning important academic vocabulary, exploring word relationships, understanding print concepts such as text direction and one-to-one correspondence, discussing genre characteristics in fiction (persuasive text, informational text, and fables), text structure (author & illustrator, characters, setting, main events, plot, topic & theme), developing text comprehension, and responding to text.

Things for Your child To practice:

- Writing first name correctly (Uppercase first letter only)
- Identifying letter names, letter sounds, and sight words
- Counting to 100
- Zipping zippers (on clothing and backpacks)
- Rhyming
- Counting by 10's to 100
- writing letters with correct formation and line placement

In writing, we will be learning about the writing process (plan & generate ideas, organize, draft, revise & edit, publish & present) when writing narratives.
