**Week of 4/29-5/3**

## Reading

This week we read a persuasive text called *In Spring* and identified the multiple reasons why the author thinks spring is the best season. We also talked about the author's word choice and how it makes the writing more interesting. This week we worked on the sounds of *ew*, *ue* as they make a long *oo* sound (words such as *blew*, *blue*, etc.) Our word wall words this week were *sentence*, *because*, *open*, *laugh* and *off*.

## Writing

This week we wrote about our favorite characters (in honor of character day on Monday). The kids are doing a great job of writing complex sentences using words like *because* and *and*. Ask them why *because* is my favorite word and how to spell it.

## Math

We started our last math module this week! This module focuses on geometry. We learned about 2-dimensional shapes, types of polygons and 3-dimensional shapes. We identified their attributes—faces, edges, vertices (aka corners). We also learned about fractions.

## Science

Between testing and the ABC countdown, there was no time for science this week.
