In the week ahead students have many things to look forward to. We have a day off on Monday thanks to Christopher Columbus and other early explorers.

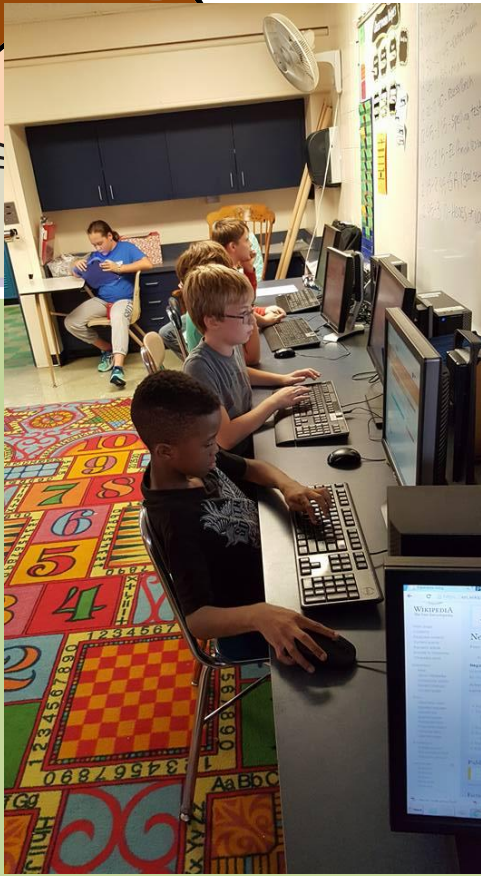
In math we will continue through the lessons in Module 1
